














OVERVIEW.

Kept in pristine condition since her launch, AMARYLLIS is now for sale. Delivered by Abeking & Rasmussen in 2011, 78.4m (257.2ft) AMARYLLIS has seen very little use in her lifetime and as such presents as a new yacht. She is an excellent opportunity to purchase a pedigree-built yacht from the renowned German builder.

AMARYLLIS has sinuous exterior lines, designed by British designer Mark Berryman. But it's her spectacular interior styling by British studio Reymond Langton Design that really make this a stand-out yacht in this sector of the market and a must-see for any qualified buyers.

The well-executed interior design was inspired by the Belle Époque, Art Nouveau and Art Deco periods and features unique furnishings including a sensuously sculpted piano. She is exceedingly glamorous while being comfortable as well, with zero speed stabilisers to deliver peace at anchor.

AMARYLLIS accommodates 12 quests, which includes an owner's deck with private terrace. The main deck has a VIP suite plus three double cabins, and one additional twin cabin is located on the lower deck. All of the cabins are noted for having walk-in wardrobes and en suite bathrooms. She has accommodations for 19 crew members.

Also found on the lower deck is a beach club with a spa and gym that opens up directly onto the sea. If a pool is preferred, there is a 5m swimming pool found on the sun deck.

AMARYLLIS has a top speed of 16.5 knots, and at 14 knots she can achieve a range of 5,085nm at 12.5 nots, powered by twin 2,000hp Caterpillar 3516 diesel engines.

AMARYLLIS is ready in all respects for a new owner to enjoy cruising onboard immediately.


