Now it's time for action; ASAH I's extensive watertoy inventory is a dream for thrill seekers. Try your hand at the dizzying array of options, under the guidance of the friendly crew. As a fun underwater family adventure, the robust Protector chase tender can quickly transport you to a nearby cove for a snorkel safari before you head to a nearby shoreline to enjoy lunch on the beach with freshly grilled seafood and creative cocktails.

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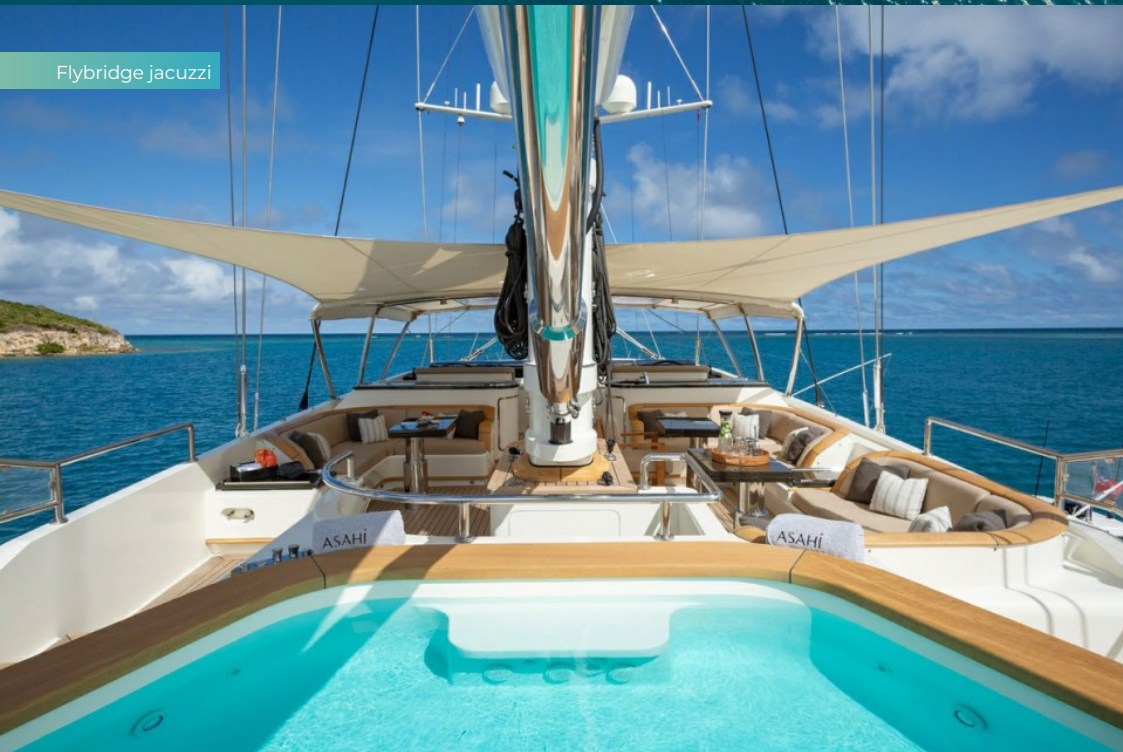

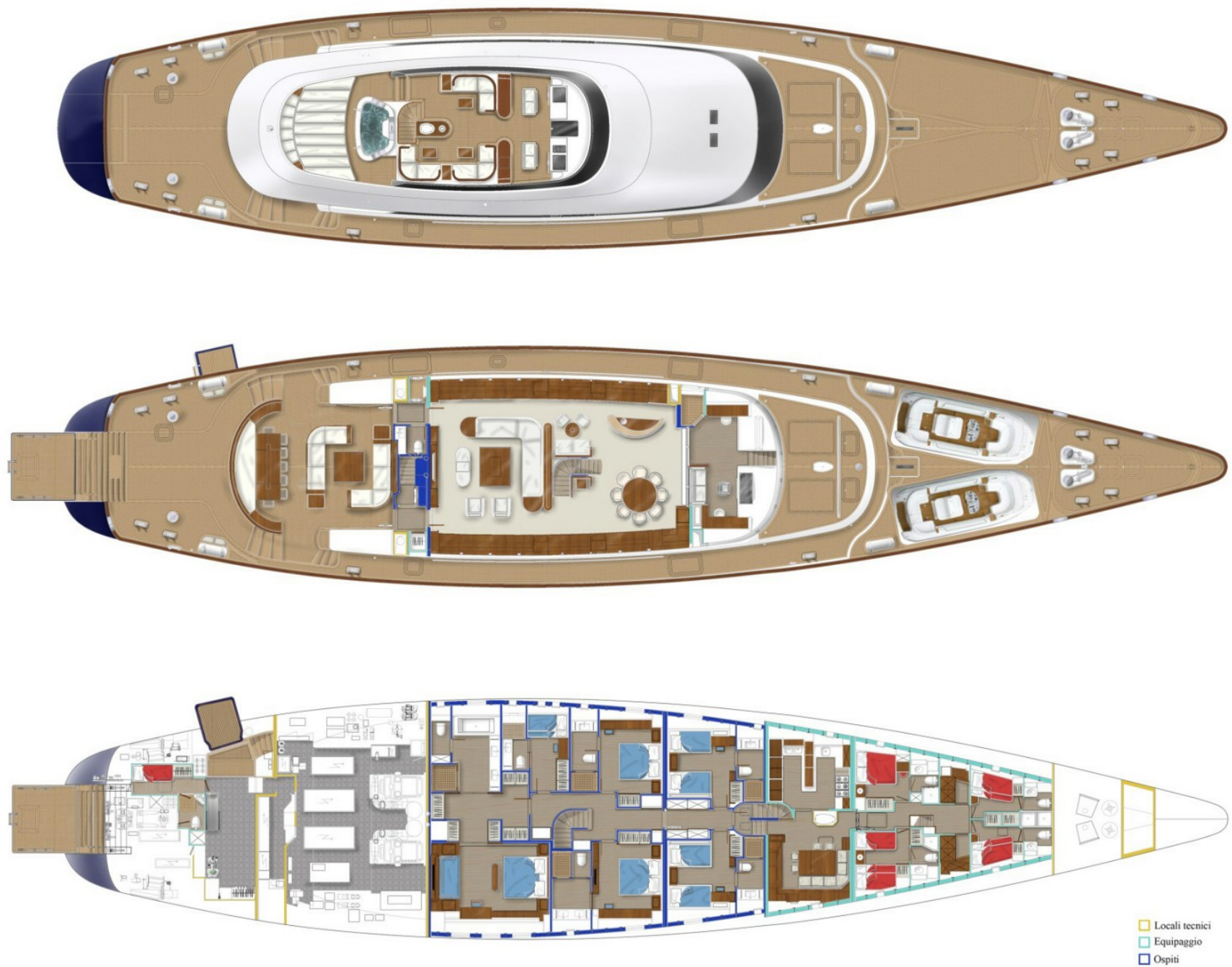
