

OVERVIEW.

If you're looking to charter a vessel that offers the perfect combination of luxury, comfort and kudos, a classic tri-deck Heesen yacht like this one is a smart and logical choice. A perennial favourite on the Bahamas and Caribbean charter circuit, the 44-metre (145ft) AT LAST has a superb record of client satisfaction and her popularity is well deserved.

Comfortable sophistication is the key to her success and you'll discover that as soon as you step aboard. Designed to host a group of up to 11 guests in five cabins, her spacious, bright and welcoming ambience sets the perfect tone for an island-hopping holiday of discovery and relaxation.

At the forward end of the main deck, the master cabin is your own private haven with a sofa, a huge TV and great sea views from the sumptuous king size bed. The marble-clad en suite bathroom adds an extra dimension of luxury with its rain room and full size bathtub.

The salons on both levels are big and bright, beautifully finished and tastefully furnished in a timeless modern-classic style. There's a lovely outdoor dining space on the upper aft deck with a big teak table – the perfect place to enjoy a sunset dinner with a commanding, panoramic view.

The sundeck is a great social hub and a nice spot for lunch with a lounge in cool shade, a sit-up bar, a jacuzzi and a plush full-beam day bed. And there's another open-air lounge on the foredeck with a walkway leading forward to sofas on the bow, so everyone can find a private nook on board.

She's well equipped for watersports with a 12-metre (39ft) chase boat with 300 horsepower as well as four Waverunners, a hover board and SeaBob water scooters, a kayak and paddleboards, a wide range of waterski and wakeboard kit for all ages and abilities, a water trampoline, a giant water slide and more.

And there's one more special feature to bear in mind. She's driven by water jets, not propellers, which enables her to safely explore the vast expanses of shallow waters in the Bahamas that are inaccessible to many large yachts, due to their deeper draught. So while others are restricted to the relatively few deep anchorages of the archipelago, which quite often get rather crowded, you'll be free to find your own private paradise.


