She can accommodate 12 guests in 6 cabins. CERULEAN's elongated bow and refined profile pay homage to the timeless heritage of classic motor yachts, while beneath this elegant silhouette lies the advanced technology, innovation, and contemporary engineering expected of a 2026 yacht project. Moreover, the hull is characterised by softly sculpted curves and fluid surfaces, creating a harmonious visual continuity between the enclosed interiors and open-air living spaces.
