DYTAN

OVERVIEW.

DYTAN represents a rare opportunity to acquire one of the most capable and extensively cruised yachts in her class. Built by German shipyard Nobiskrug and delivered in 2012, the 73.5m yacht has completed a circumnavigation, cruising extensively throughout Alaska, Costa Rica, the Galápagos, French Polynesia, Bali, the Maldives and South Africa. Designed by Reymond Langton Design and built in steel and aluminium to Germanischer Lloyd's class, DYTAN combines long-range capability with substantial on board volume. Her 7,000nm range, top speed of 17 knots and fuel consumption of approximately 315 litres per hour at 13.8 knots make her a highly capable platform for extended cruising.

Offering 1,682GT of internal volume, DYTAN accommodates 12 guests in six cabins. The full-beam owner's suite features a folding sea terrace providing 180-degree views at main deck level, while a bridge deck VIP suite and four additional guest cabins offer flexible accommodation arrangements.

The Asian-inspired interior benefits from exceptional 2.5m headroom throughout and includes a glass elevator serving the guest decks. Additional guest amenities include a private cinema, gym, beach club with massage and steam rooms, and a variety of lounge and entertainment spaces. Exterior spaces are arranged across multiple deck levels and include a helipad, jacuzzi, substantial deck areas for dining and entertaining, an outdoor cinema and a large swim platform with a floating beach club setup. The yacht also carries an extensive inventory of tenders and watertoys, including a 10m open limousine tender, 8m RIB, two jet skis, three SeaBobs and diving equipment.

DYTAN has benefitted from consistent technical investment and maintenance, including main engine overhauls, a Quantum XT zero-speed stabiliser upgrade, SEA.AI thermal camera installation, a 3.2-tonne touch-and-go-rated helipad, HUG emissions system installation and a full repaint completed in 2019.

With an asking price of EUR 75,000,000, DYTAN presents a compelling opportunity to acquire a proven long-range yacht with significant volume, extensive amenities and a well-documented cruising history.
