

OVERVIEW.

An exceptional, powerful and beautiful sailing yacht on an impressive scale, the 50m (163ft) sloop OHANA offers a winning combination of ample living space and high-level luxury with superb performance and handling under sail. She's equally ideal as a holiday platform for relaxed family cruising, as a highly competitive contender in any superyacht regatta, or as a safe and seaworthy ocean voyager for blue water adventures.

Extensively upgraded in a major refit in 2023, OHANA is designed to host 10 guests on board in five cabins with a crew of eight at your service. She has a gorgeous contemporary interior, finished in whitewashed oak, and her sailing systems are state of the art.

One of her best features is a superb sundeck that puts you safely at the heart of the sailing action and provides an excellent open-air social space when she's anchored in a tranquil bay, Another is the snug, secure and spacious aft cockpit, which can be fully enclosed or open to let the sea air flow through its lounge and dining areas.

There's a seamless flow from the aft cockpit into the main deck lounge, which is a stunning yet soothing, wideopen living space with sweeping views of the seascape. The transparent perspex companionway steps leading up to the sundeck are a nice touch that enhances the feeling of ample space. A fine marble dining table is on one side of the lounge with a sofa further aft. There's a comfortable lounge with a projector screen cinema system and a bar on the other side. With a separate pilothouse up forward for the captain and crew, the lounge is entirely devoted to guests.

The master suite is a plush and roomy full-beam cabin with a king size bed on the centreline, a study desk on one side, a sofa on the other, and a marble en suite bathroom. The other four cabins are two VIP doubles and two twins which are almost the same size, each with its own private en suite bathroom.

She has a vast expanse of deck space for guests to spread out and enjoy when the anchor goes down, with plenty of awnings for shade. She carries two tenders, one of which is an 11m (36ft) RIB for comfortable ship-to-shore transfers and beach landings, and her inventory of toys includes windsurfers, paddleboards, a dive compressor and gear, a wide range of waterski kit and more.


