RAIJIN is a 39m (127.9ft) sailing yacht built by Nautor Swan. She is of carbon construction and was delivered in 2026. Her exterior design is by Lucio Micheletti and luxurious interior by Misa Poggi.

She can accommodate 8 guests in 4 cabins, attended by a professional crew of 5. RAIJIN is characterized by her masterful blend of classic styling and clean, sculpted lines, enhanced by a thoughtful interplay of materials that create striking contrasts of light and shadow, resulting in a dynamic and refined aesthetic.

RAIJIN's exterior has been thoughtfully designed to maximise life on the water. At her centre is a spacious cockpit that provides an inviting setting for dining, relaxing, and taking in the scenery while under sail. The aft beach club offers direct access to the sea, serving as a flexible space for unwinding or launching the tender. Generous sunbathing and lounge areas on the foredeck and fly areas further enhance the onboard experience, combining comfort, practicality, and effortless enjoyment throughout the yacht.

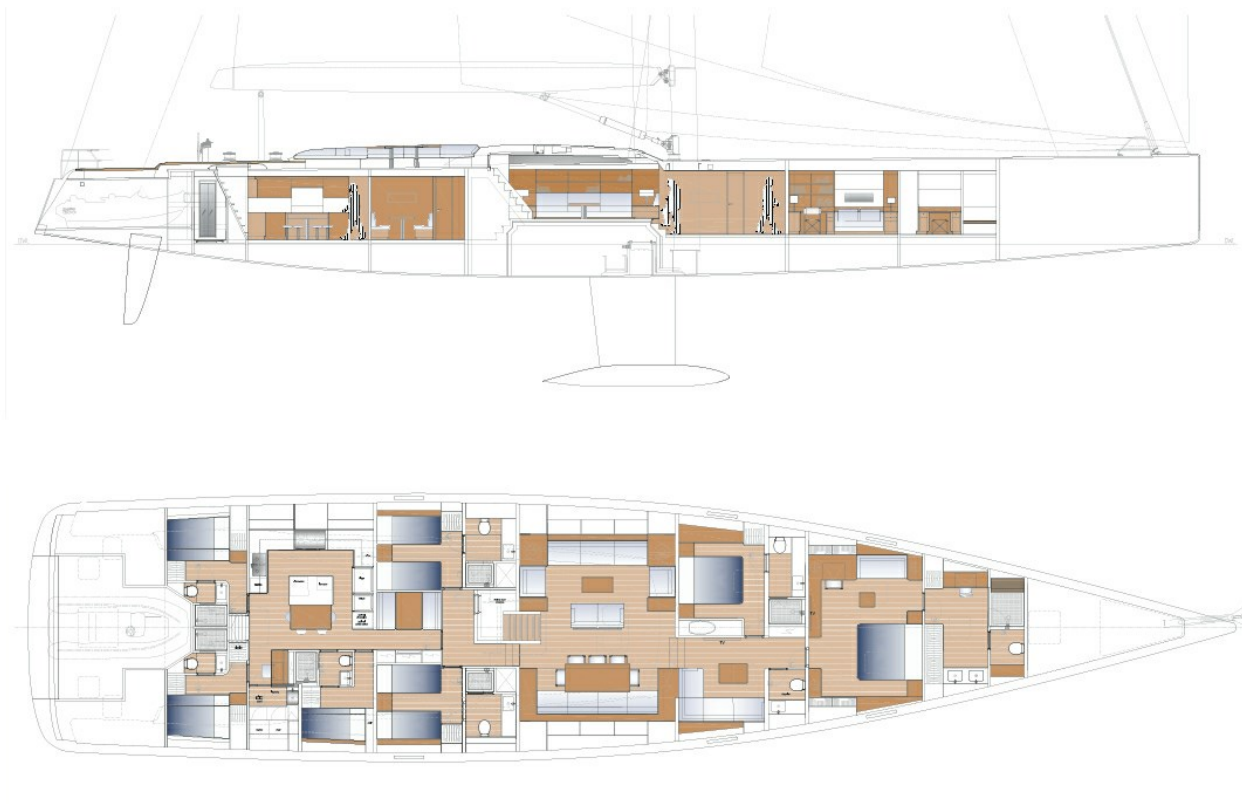

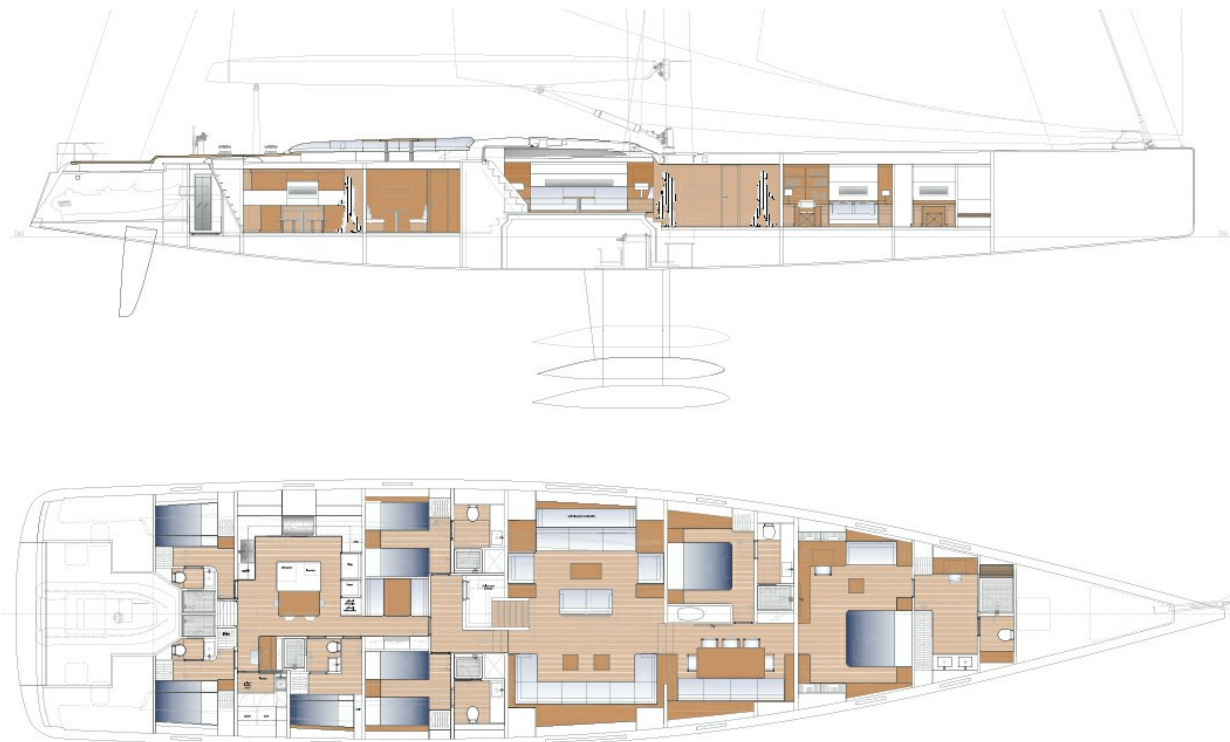
