














OVERVIEW.

The 42m (140ft) Stefano Righini-designed superyacht SOY AMOR was delivered by Benetti in 2014. With a François Zuretti interior and accommodation for 10 guests in five cabins, she was designed for cruising in comfort and style.

The sun deck is the hub of the yacht and entirely devoted to guest enjoyment. A double sunpad provides excellent views forward, there is a BBQ grill amidships, as well as a foldaway TV and a bar with a trio of bar stools. An awning in the superstructure can be opened to cast sunlight onto the al fresco dining table and wide sofas of the seating area, or closed to provide shade. Further sunbathing space is provided by four sun loungers and parasols positioned aft, and a separate scenic sunbathing area with sunpads and sofas can be found forward of the bridge on the upper deck.

The Zuretti team has created stylish but comfortable interior guest spaces incorporating cream and grey soft furnishings with accents of tan leather, and an abundance of contrasting textures. The upper deck is the main living area for guests and, in a departure from the traditional yacht layout, the dining table is located in the sky lounge. From the upper aft deck seating area sliding doors open onto a large rectangular dining table for 12 guests. The wide glass doors can be left open for an indoor-outdoor dining experience, or closed to create a cosy ambience with the backlit fireplace and bar in the lounging area.


The main saloon provides a sophisticated reception area and a relaxing space to watch TV from one of the many deep sofas, while the uncluttered aft deck offers further outdoor lounging space. Steps lead down to the beach club which allows guests to enjoy the proximity of the water, and includes a bar and sunloungers.


The accommodation is divided between the main and lower decks with the full width master suite positioned forward on the main deck. The owner's suite features window seats to port and starboard and an en suite bathroom with his and hers basins. On the lower deck two mirror image double cabins, a twin cabin and a convertible cabin, all with en suite marble bathrooms, are positioned amidships.
